## A BILL

To recognize the significance of the AIDS Memorial Grove, located in Golden Gate Park in San Francisco, California, and to direct the Secretary of the Interior to designate the AIDS Memorial Grove as a national memorial.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “AIDS Memorial Grove  
5 Act of 1996”.

1 **SEC. 2. RECOGNITION AND DESIGNATION OF THE AIDS ME-**  
2 **MORIAL GROVE AS NATIONAL MEMORIAL.**

3 (a) RECOGNITION OF SIGNIFICANCE OF THE AIDS  
4 MEMORIAL GROVE.—The Congress hereby recognizes the  
5 significance of the AIDS Memorial Grove, located in Gold-  
6 en Gate Park in San Francisco, California, as a memo-  
7 rial—

8 (1) dedicated to individuals who have died as a  
9 result of acquired immune deficiency syndrome; and

10 (2) in support of individuals who are living with  
11 acquired immune deficiency syndrome and their  
12 loved ones and caregivers.

13 (b) DESIGNATION AS NATIONAL MEMORIAL.—Not  
14 later than 90 days after the date of the enactment of this  
15 Act, the Secretary of the Interior shall designate the AIDS  
16 Memorial Grove as a national memorial.
